



Replacing a Field Unit

Periodically it becomes necessary to replace mobile computing equipment. Here is how to move TraCS from the old unit to the new one.

Back-up the Old Field Unit

Backing up is as simple as copying the existing TraCS folder onto a thumb-drive. Doing so will make the data available to transfer to the new field unit.

Install TraCS on the New Field Unit

Install TraCS as a new installation onto the new Field Unit. Follow the instructions included with the TraCS Installation Package.

Copy Files from the Old Installation

With thumb-drive inserted, copy the contents of the following folders and files into the TraCS folder on the new unit:

Directories

- \TraCS\DBData\
- \TraCS\Document\
- \TraCS\Users\

Files

- \TraCS\Settings\MachineID.ini
- \TraCS\Settings\NewYorkSettings.ini
- \TraCS\Settings\Communications.set.xml
- \TraCS\mobilesettings.xml (if using TraCS Transfer)

Configuring the Scanner

Follow the instructions included with the TraCS Installation DVD to install the scanner, driver, and set the port configurations.

If Using Wireless Transfer, Install TraCS Transfer

If previously installed, install TraCS Transfer onto the new Field Unit. Follow the instructions included with the TraCS Installation DVD. Be sure also to manually create the directory that TraCS Transfer scans for End Shift files if not using the default TraCSftp directory.
